



# Earn your Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential

Now required for GA Pre-K Assistant Teachers

**What is a CDA?** The CDA is a nationally recognized child development credential.

**Who can attend the course?** Child care teachers and family child care providers must be 18 years of age; have a high school diploma or equivalency; have 480 hours (4 months) of experience with children 0-5 by the end of the course; and currently work directly with a group of infants, toddlers or preschool children in a Bright From the Start licensed child care center or registered family child care home.

**What does training cost?** The class will cost a **\$90 registration fee** and an additional **\$130 due monthly** (7 total monthly payments plus registration fee), plus your time and commitment to attend all the classes and complete the application process for a CDA.

**When and where is it?** Each class will meet 15 Saturdays, from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm. The class will be held at Oak Grove Kids, 850 Buford Drive, Lawrenceville, GA 30043.
