Play & Learn

Play & Learn is a facilitated playgroup for children 0-5 and their caregivers. It is designed to meet the needs of any adult caring for children 0-5, including parents, grandparents, guardians, foster parents, and child care providers. Play & Learn provides children and their caregivers the opportunity to come together in a safe and stimulating environment for fun and learning.

Play & Learn Groups utilize activity centers with developmentally appropriate toys and materials that are set up to allow each child to choose an activity that interests them most. The centers include such areas as science, art and music, working with blocks and puzzles, and dramatic play. As the children choose the activity that interests them, the facilitator spends time with each child and caregiver modeling appropriate play and interaction.

Caregivers discover the importance of play in children's learning and how they can support learning through their own involvement. The children have an opportunity to develop important social skills and experience developmental activities that they may not experience in a home setting.



Play & Learn is perfect for teen mom groups, playgroups, parents morning out groups, support groups for foster parents or grandparents, father groups, and parent groups. It also works well with faith-based organizations, child care centers or family child care homes. There is no fee for participating.
