By Gail Gibbons

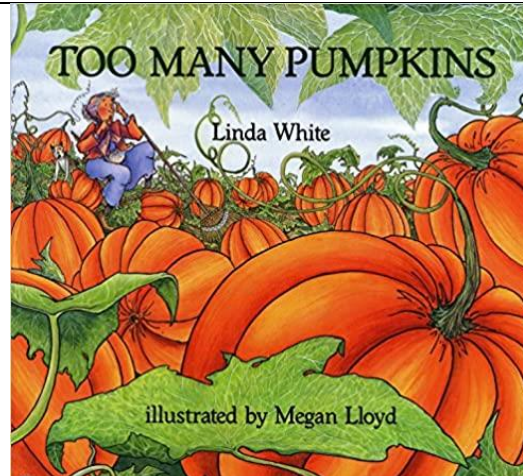

Bold, autumn-colored paintings and a simple but lively story capture a little girl's joy and satisfaction as she shares in the excitement of the fall season.

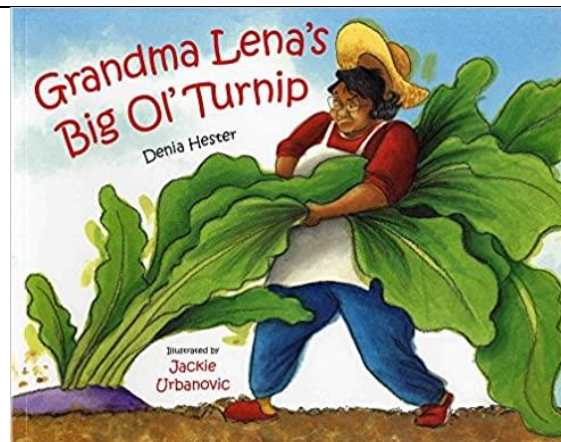

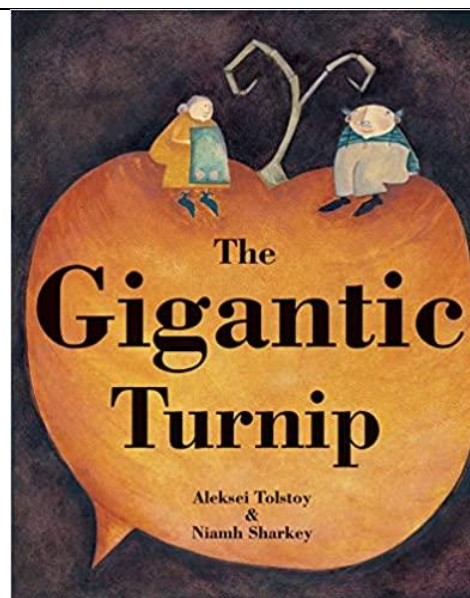

By Aleksei Tolstoy

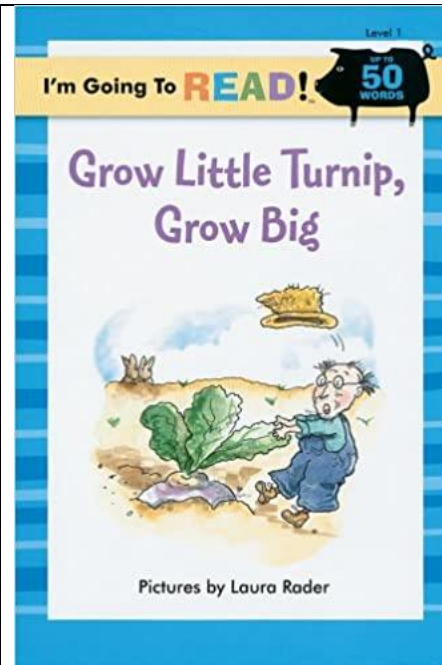
